

VOLUNTEER COVENANT STATEMENT

Since the congregation of Munholland U.M.C. is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for all children, youth, and volunteers who participate in ministries and activities sponsored by the church, we ask all volunteers to willingly, and without reservation, enter into the following covenant. This covenant is based upon our congregation's commitment to preserving this church as a holy place of safety and protection for all who would enter as expressed in our "Safe Sanctuaries and Risk Reduction Policy for Munholland UMC." This is the way, in part, in which we live out our commitment to:

- "reasonable safety measures in the selection and recruitment of both staff persons and volunteers"
 - "implement prudent operational procedures in all programs, ministries and events"
 - "provide broad education regarding our policies"
 - having "a clearly defined procedure for reporting a suspected incident of abuse."
- a) No adult who has been convicted of child abuse (either sexual abuse, physical abuse, or emotional abuse) should volunteer to work with children or youth in any church-sponsored activity.
 - b) Adult survivors of child abuse need the love and support of our congregation. Any adult survivor who desires to volunteer in some capacity to work with children or youth is encouraged to discuss his/her willingness with our church minister before accepting an assignment.
 - c) All adult volunteers involved with children or youth of our church must have been members of the congregation for at least six months before beginning a volunteer assignment.
 - d) Adult volunteers with children and youth shall observe the "Two-Adult Rule" at all times so that no adult is ever alone with children or youth.
 - e) Adult volunteers with children and youth SHALL ATTEND REGULAR TRAINING AND EDUCATIONAL EVENTS provided by the church to keep volunteers informed of church policies and state laws regarding child abuse.
 - f) Adult volunteers shall immediately intervene and report to their designated supervisor any behavior that seems abusive or inappropriate.
